



ATTENDEE LOGIN INFORMATION

- Click the “Attendee link” you received by email and you will be taken to the Virtual Platform.
- We suggest that you “bookmark” this page on your browser to be able to access it later on.

HOW TO ACCESS THE AGENDA

- Access the Congress schedule by clicking on the ‘AGENDA’ tab (1) at the top of the page.
- Select the **filter dropdown** (2) to filter by:
 - Time
 - Exhibitor
 - Program session (GS01, RC14, LOC03, CT, APSA, etc.)
 - Type (RC Business Meetings, Plenaries, Award Sessions, Ceremonies, Sponsored Sessions, etc.)
- Save panels or sessions by clicking on the **star symbol** (3). These panels will be filed under ‘My Interests’ (4).
- You can also search for a specific panel by typing its code or title in the search box (5).
